



Contest Rules

Educational and creative version of the Cyberdento Shorts festival for participants under 18

1. Name and Purpose of the Contest

Cyberdento Futur is a short film contest aimed at young creators aged **up to 18**, with the goal of promoting **creativity, audiovisual literacy, and artistic expression** among students in schools and high schools.

We want to see how you imagine the future, how you tell the impossible, and how you dare to tell stories beyond the ordinary.

2. Theme

Short films must be related to **fantasy, imagination, or science fiction**, from the perspective of young creators.

Accepted genres include:

Futurism, adventure, humor, light horror, animation, social commentary, technology, alternative worlds...

Creativity and narrative freedom are essential, as long as the content is **age-appropriate and suitable for educational settings**.

3. Who Can Participate

- Open to individuals **up to 18 years old**.
- Participation can be **individual or in groups** (through schools or independently).
- Maximum of **2 short films per participant or team**.
- If underage, **a signed parental/legal guardian consent** form is mandatory.

4. Duration

Each short film must be **90 seconds or less**.

5. Technical Requirements

- **Video format:** .mp4 (minimum resolution 1920x1080)
- **Orientation:** free (horizontal, vertical, or square)
- **Language:** any, but must include **Spanish subtitles** if the original language is different
- **Technique:** free (animation, live action, stop-motion, AI, illustration, etc.)

6. Registration

- **Registration period:** from **June 22 to July 31, 2025**
- Registration must be completed through the form available at:

Required Documents:

- Short film (.mp4)
- Registration form
- Data protection consent form
- Parental/legal guardian consent form

- (Optional) Promotional poster or cover image

Submission:

- Place all files in a folder
- Upload via WeTransfer, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.

7. Awards and Recognition

- 🏆 **Cyberdento Futur Jury Prize:** official distinction, screening at the gala, and tech gear
- 🎁 **Three annual subscriptions to acontra+** for participating schools
- ★ **Special mentions** for short films that stand out in originality, message, creativity, or technique
- Selected works may be **included in the acontra+ streaming platform catalog**
- Educational centers will receive **special recognition** if any of their students are awarded

8. Screening and Final Gala

The selected short films will be screened at the **Cyberdento Futur Gala**, held on **September 30, 2025**, at the **Cines Verdi in Barcelona**.

This will be an educational and celebratory event with the participation of students, teachers, families, and professionals from the audiovisual world.

9. Intellectual Property and Usage Rights

- Authors will retain **full rights** to their work.
- The organization may screen the short films at the gala, on its website, social media, and promotional platforms.
- **No commercial use** will be made of the works.
- The use of image and voice of minor participants will be covered by the **signed consent form** provided by their legal guardian.

10. Jury

The jury will be composed of professionals from the audiovisual sector, the educational field, and the 207 team.

Their decision will be **final and not subject to appeal**.

11. Evaluation Criteria

The jury and the 207 team will assess each short film based on the following **scoring system**:

- Originality – 25 points
- Technical quality – 20 points
- Relevance to the theme – 20 points
- Teamwork and group cohesion – 15 points
- Social impact and narrative message – 20 points
- Inclusion impact – 5 points
- Sustainability impact – 5 points

12. Final Conditions

- Participation in the contest implies **full acceptance** of these rules.
- All short films must be **original works** created by the participants.
- The organization is not responsible for the misuse of content protected by copyright.
- If a participant is selected but **cannot attend the gala**, a **thank-you video** must be submitted, which may be screened during the event and shared on social media. **Failure to comply** with this requirement may result in disqualification.
- **207 reserves the right** to modify the contest dates due to organizational reasons or force majeure.
- All personal data will be handled in accordance with the **European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)**, exclusively for the management of the contest.

13. Image and Voice Rights – Participants and Attendees

Participants and gala attendees authorize the use of their **image and voice** for documentation and dissemination purposes, which may include:

- Recording of interviews during the gala or associated activities
- Distribution of the event on social media and platforms associated with **Cyberdento Futur**
- Use of this material in the potential creation of a **documentary** about the contest and its impact. This authorization is granted for non-commercial purposes only, and exclusively for cultural, educational, and promotional use related to the festival.
