

CYBER-DENTO SHORTS

Contest Rules

1. Name and Purpose of the Contest

Cyberdento Shorts is a short film festival that aims to explore the **fantasy genre** through innovative visual storytelling. The goal is to give visibility to emerging creators who want to experiment with unconventional ideas.

2. Theme

Short films in any genre within the realm of the fantastic and imaginative are accepted: **Science fiction, horror, suspense, comedy, thriller, cyberpunk...** or any proposal that escapes the boundaries of “boring reality.”

3. Who Can Participate

- Open to **creators worldwide**, regardless of nationality or experience.
- Both **professionals and amateurs** are welcome.
- **Minimum age**: 18 years old
- Maximum of **2 short films per person or group**

4. Duration

Each short film must be **90 seconds or less**.

5. Technical Requirements

- **Video format:** .mp4 (minimum resolution 1920x1080)
- **Orientation:** free (horizontal, vertical, square)
- **Language:** any, but must include **Spanish subtitles** if not spoken in Spanish
- **Technique:** free (animation, live action, stop-motion, AI, etc.)

6. Registration

- **Submission period:** from **July 20 to August 20, 2025**
- Registration must be completed through the official form available at:

Required documents:

- Short film (.mp4)
- Registration form
- Data protection consent form
- Poster or promotional image (optional)

Submission:

- Place all files in one folder
- Upload via **WeTransfer**, **Google Drive**, **Dropbox**, etc.

7. Categories and Prizes

- 🏆 **Jury Prize:** €1,000 + exclusive trophy
- ❤️ **Audience Award:** €500 (based on votes on social media)

8. Screening and Awards Gala

The finalist short films will be screened during the **Awards Gala** on **October 8, 2025**, at the **Cines Verdi in Barcelona**.

The event will include Q&A sessions with creators and an art exhibition inspired by the Cyberdento universe.

9. Audience Voting

Voting will take place via **Instagram and other social media platforms**.

The short film that receives the most likes within the voting period will be declared the winner of the **Audience Award**.

10. Intellectual Property and Usage Rights

- Participants retain **all copyright** to their work.
- The organization may **exhibit the films** during the festival, on its website, and through social media channels, always respecting the author's credit.
- Any use **outside the scope of the festival** will require prior written authorization.
- The organization reserves the right to use the selected short films for **promotional purposes** of both the festival and the works themselves, always within a **non-commercial and cultural framework**.
- The legal representative of the film guarantees that the submitted work is **original** and that they hold **all the necessary rights**.
The organization is **not responsible** for any legal issues related to copyright infringement.

11. Jury

- The jury will be composed of **renowned professionals** from the audiovisual industry.
- The jury's decisions will be **final and not subject to appeal**.
- The jury reserves the right to **declare a category void** if the submissions do not meet the expected quality standards.

12. Final Conditions

- If a winner **cannot attend the closing gala**, they must send a **thank-you video** to be screened during the event.
This video may also be used on the organization's **social media and promotional materials**.
Failure to comply with this requirement may result in disqualification.
- Prizes will be awarded **exclusively during the gala on October 8, 2025**.
- **207 reserves the right** to modify the contest dates due to force majeure.
- Participation in the contest implies **full acceptance** of these rules.

13. Image and Voice Rights – Participants and Attendees

Participants and attendees of the awards gala **authorize the use of their image and voice** for the documentation and dissemination of the event, which may include:

- Recording of interviews during the gala or related activities
- Distribution of content on **Cyberdento Shorts' social media and partner platforms**
- Use of material in the potential production of a **documentary about the contest and its impact**. This release is granted for non-commercial purposes only, and strictly within the cultural, educational, and promotional scope of the festival.
